A. Objective and Scope of Work

Updates were made to this section on page 3 (*shown in blue font*) to be more consistent with the Project Budget Estimates on page 16 of this RFP.

B. Project Budget Estimates

1. The "Communication & consultation with WSSDA committees and staff" scope of work (page 3) is not listed in the Compensation and Payment terms (page 16). What is the proposed compensation for this service area?

We envision this to be included in "Conference/meeting." We will change the heading to conference management and meeting planning. The change is shown in blue font.

2. The "Keynote Speaker Logistics" scope of work (page 3) is not listed in the Compensation and Payment terms page (page 16). What is your proposed compensation for this service area?

We envision it is included in Speaker/Proposed Administrative work and management. Also, we can specifically identify this area in the final contract.

3. It appears as if the scope of work "Session (breakouts, pre-conference) surveying, scheduling, and placement" has been included in the "Speaker/Proposed Administrative work and management" in the Compensation and Payment Terms (page 16), is this correct?

It is up to your discretion whether to include it. We think it is included in both "Speaker/Proposed Administrative work and management" and conference management and meeting planning.
