## What can a WSSDA Position Proposal do?

WSSDA Position Proposals can do the following:
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Recommend a <b><i>change</i></b> to an existing Permanent or Legislative Position</li><li>• Recommend the <b><i>consolidation</i></b> of one or more existing Permanent or Legislative Positions</li><li>• Propose a <b><i>new</i></b> Permanent or Legislative Position</li><li>• Recommend the <b><i>retirement</i></b> of an existing Permanent or Legislative Position</li></ul>
